Welcome to the 3rd CRISM Atlantic Symposium Informing Research and Intervention in Substance Use. Being able to host the Symposium in a different Atlantic Province each year has allowed the CRISM Quebec Atlantic (CRISM QA) Node to actively engage original members while also growing and reaching out to new communities and introducing new members.

The 3rd CRISM Atlantic Symposium begins Tuesday, November 5th in the evening (6 PM) with a reception and two speaker sessions and Wednesday, November 6th is a full day (9 AM-3 PM). 

SCENIC DRIVES

CAVENDISH TO FRENCH RIVER - 18 KM

Remember reading *Anne of Green Gables* as a kid? You can visit her home in Cavendish before zipping over to French River, one of the most-painted panoramas on the Island with its rolling hills, colourful farmhouses, and crisp blue bay.

WOOD ISLANDS TO POINT PRIM - 29.81 KM

Explore the beach at Wood Islands Provincial Park, while you watch the ferries roll into the harbour from Nova Scotia. Then, set off on a half-hour drive to Point Prim, home of the Island's oldest lighthouse, and climb to the top for a stunning view of Northumberland Strait.

ALBERTON TO SEACOW POND - 29.8 K.M

The quaint, historic town of Alberton embodies the Island's commitment to fishing, farming, and business and proudly displays its past with murals placed in different village locations. A half-hour drive will fake you to the very tip of the island to Seacow Pond, with its bustting marina, majestic wind turbines, and a Natural rock reef perfect for exploring.

BUFFALOLAND PROVINCIAL PARK, 1206 LINE RD, MONTAGUE, PE

The boardwalk, leads to a wooden deck which overlooks a 100-acre enclosure where the herd of about 25 of these large and dramatic animals graze. The original buffalo were a gift to the Prince Edward Island government from the Province of Alberta. The Buffalo land Provincial Park is located within the Points East Coastal Drive touring region.
